
Lenmar oil-based glazes are formulated to allow the professional finisher wide latitude in visual techniques.

- Sand the sealer or topcoat before applying glaze.
- Apply by spray, brush or rag. Ten minute open time allows creation of any desired effect.
- Dry time varies on amount of glaze applied, usually 45 minutes to 2 hours.
- Should be topcoated the same day.

Many times, each application of a glaze is a unique use. We suggest testing each finish for color and adhesion on sample wood before beginning any production.

The series consists of four standard colors and a base (1GZ.1000) used for making unique colors (Tint using industrial colorants).

Lenmar® Breakaway Glaze Base is formulated to be tinted with standard industrial colorants. It creates an opportunity for a different approach to glazing. Designed to be applied by spray only, it dries quickly (within 10 minutes), can be removed with Scotch-Brite pads to achieve various visual effects, and can be topcoated immediately after removal.

Nine formulations for standard colors are given below; however other colors can be created from this base (Tint using industrial colorants).


